## **International travel requirements**

## ⇒ K-ETA: electronic travel authorization

You can check through the visa navigator on the Korea visa <u>portal</u> whether your visit falls under the visa exemption. If you prefer to obtain professional visa advice, please contact a Korean consulate in your country of residence, mentioning that it is a scientific visit to a government funded research institute which does not involve any direct monetary support.

If you do not need a visa to enter the Republic in Korea, your visit formalities should be completed by applying for K-ETA electronic travel authorization at <a href="https://www.k-eta.go.kr/portal/apply/viewstep1.do">https://www.k-eta.go.kr/portal/apply/viewstep1.do</a>

unless your country of origin is also exempt from K-ETA (provided you fill out an arrival card), which you can check <u>here</u>.

## ⇒ COVID-19 prevention

Currently, there are no longer any COVID-19 arrival policies in Korea, namely:

- no vaccination requirement,
- Q-code registration is no longer required,
- no COVID-19 test requirement,
- no quarantine.

It should take less than an hour to get through the immigration and customs.
